**ORDER**

The above-entitled matter came on for hearing before Referee Marybeth Dorn  
on January 8, 1991

Paul Shoemaker and Steven Pyle, Esq., appeared as counsel for and on behalf of petitioner.

Tom Racette, Esq., appeared as counsel for and on behalf of respondent.

Based upon the evidence adduced, the argument of counsel, and all of the files, records and proceedings herein.

THE COURT FINDS:

1. According to the petitioner's testimony, approximately 1 1/2 months ago, an incident occurred outside of the petitioner's residence. The petitioner claims that she was fearful of the respondent at that time. The respondent did become angry at that time, because the petitioner refused to permit the children to go with the respondent for visitation. If the petitioner was fearful of imminent physical harm from the respondent at that time, her fear was not based in fact or a result of the respondent's actions.

2. The petitioner has failed to meet her burden of proof that there is a need for an order for protection for herself or the children at this time or that the respondent has perpetrated acts of physical abuse to her or the children or placed them in reasonable fear of imminent physical harm within the reasonable past.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The petitioner's request for an order for protection is denied and the Ex Parte Order for Protection dated December 24, 1990 is hereby dismissed.

The foregoing facts were found by me after due hearing and the foregoing Order thereon is recommended.
